

Tipping in Italy

Tipping in Italy is considered a “bonus,” so the amount should reflect the level of service and is solely up to you.

Suggestions based on what is considered standard practice:

Café Server: Leave the change or round up to the nearest euro on the total bill.

Restaurant Server: The tip is sometimes included in the final bill (*servizio incluso*), but not always. If the service isn't included, a tip of 10 to 15 percent is encouraged. If the service is included, and the meal exceeded your expectations, round the bill up to the nearest €10.

Bartender: Round up to the nearest euro per drink.

Taxis: A tip isn't expected, but is appreciated. Round up to the nearest euro for a short trip and to the nearest 10 euro for a longer ride.

Airport Shuttle Driver: It is not necessary to tip your driver, but feel free to give €1 per bag if they help with your luggage.

Doorman: A simple “grazie” will suffice, but you can also tip €1 when helped with hailing a cab or bringing in your luggage.

Bellhop: It is customary to tip €1 to €2 per bag, depending on size, but no more than €5.

Housecleaning: Depending on the cleanliness of your room each day, you can tip anywhere from €.50 to €1.50 per day.

Concierge: If the concierge goes above and beyond with helping you book reservations, giving you directions, and providing insider recommendations, it's considerate to tip €1 to €2.

Stylist: Tipping in salons isn't common, but it never hurts to round up to the nearest €10 when in doubt.

Spa Service Provider: A tip isn't expected, but you can leave up to 10 percent for exceptional service.



Trains - Finding the Train Car Once on the Platform

Typically you will see a (1) or a (2) or the words “First” or “Second” or a combination of both on the outside of the train car indicating First or Second class. Once you board the train, you'll notice that some trains have inside indicators for first or second class. Some high speed trains have headrest covers that state the class of service.

For certain high speed trains such as the Thalys, TGV, or Eurostar you'll also find displays right on the platform indicating where each car of the train will be located for boarding. You can use this chart to find the mark on the platform corresponding to the car you would like to board. It is a good rule of thumb to arrive at the station early so that you can find the train and the right car matching the class of service on your pass or ticket.

And of course, you can always ask a railway official or conductor for assistance.



Trains - Luggage

Rail Europe:

Technically, you're not restricted in terms of luggage. However, keep in mind that you'll need to carry your bags through the train station and onto the train. Once on board you'll need to find a place to put your bag(s). Small and medium sized bags typically fit on racks located above the seats. Larger suitcases and such can be stored in luggage racks found near the train door entrance.

Be aware that you are responsible for your luggage. The railways assume no responsibility in case of loss or theft of baggage carried on board.

Your bag(s) must be properly labeled with your first and last name. In general, it's a good idea to keep luggage tags on your baggage for easy identification.

Trains - Strike

A national strike impacting rail services could affect train travel for locals and visitors alike. Typically, during a rail strike there will be a reduced number of trains operating which could lead to more passengers on board trains that are running, changes in schedules, or even alternate modes of transportation (such as buses) to transport passengers to their destinations.

In the event of a strike, Rail Europe will provide as much information as possible to assist those who may be impacted. **If you're already in Europe during a strike, go directly to a railway station and ask the local railway official for assistance.**

How to Use Public Transportation in Venice

Different Kinds of Boats

- **Vaporetto** (vah|poh|REHT|toh) – Big bus-boats which have regular routes along, for instance, the Grand Canal and from Venice to Murano to Burano, etc.
- **Gondola** (GOHN|doh|lah) – Quintessential image of Venice, and are available for private hire for leisure cruises around the city's canals.
- **Traghetto** (trah|GET|toh) – Ferries passengers across the Grand Canal at various points where there isn't a canal-spanning bridge nearby. It is the same basic boat structure as a gondola, but is simpler in design and has a series of bench-like seats along the body of the boat. It is typically piloted by two gondoliers, not one.

Riding Vaporetti in Venice

Vaporetti essentially run along the Grand Canal and between islands in the Venetian lagoon. On the Grand Canal, go to the closest vaporetto stop and check the list of stops that particular line serves. To travel to one of the other islands, find the stop from which the vaporetto you want departs.

Vaporetto Tickets

A single ticket buys you 75 minutes of travel time on the vaporetto for €7.50.

Validate your ticket in the machines available at each vaporetto station just before you walk the plank toward the canal and the vaporetto.

Main Vaporetto Tourist Line

The **#1 Vaporetto** line (the tourist line) runs the length of the Grand Canal and stops at every point between the train station and Piazza San Marco. It takes 45 min - 1 hour to get between those two points.

The **#2 Vaporetto** is faster, stopping at only a few points between the train station and San Marco, but it's only a seasonal line.

Venice train station to Piazza San Marco

Venice has 2 train stations, Venice Mestre is on the mainland, and **Venice Santa Lucia** is on the island directly on the Grand Canal with a big vaporetto stop.

Riding Gondole in Venice

There are official gondola fares in Venice. Knowing what the current official fare will prevent you from over-paying. Also, taking a gondola ride at one time of day or in one part of the city can be a very different experience (and very not-romantic) than at other times or from other places.

Riding Traghetto in Venice

Typical fare is €1-2 per crossing. Walk up, give the necessary coins to the gondolier (or sometimes just leave them in a pile with other coins at the end of the boat when boarding), and file toward the end of the traghetto. They do not have a set schedule, but do not wait long to across the canal. Most people stand as they cross the Grand Canal, disembarking quickly on the other side.
